OUR BOLD PLAN

In living our mission to share Christ in our community, St. Paul's preschool classes have been a dependable draw to grow and sustain our healthy elementary grades. When parents experience the love and care of our Christian teachers, they are eager to have their children continue their education at St. Paul.

Site Improvements - \$2,500,000

Construction of new parking facilities, including a south lot by the gymnasium with EV charging stations and a dedicated preschool parent lot near the main entrance. The existing main parking lot will be fully reconstructed. Storm water detention capacity will be expanded while preserving the soccer fields. The refuse area will be relocated and properly screened. Fire hydrant locations will be optimized to enhance safety coverage across the campus.

Furnishings & Equipment - \$500,000

New furnishings will include tables, chairs, student desks, mobile book shelving, wall-mounted boards, monitors, and kitchenette appliances.

Building Renovations - \$1,850,000

A new Library/Media Center will be constructed. The current library space will be converted into a fourth preschool classroom with supporting amenities, including a kitchenette and storage areas. The east/west elementary wing will receive comprehensive fire suppression systems. All preschool classrooms, both new and existing, will be equipped with cooling systems. Two new access points will be added: a south entrance between the gymnasium and kitchen, and a building egress leading to the future playground west of the building, positioned just south of the fine arts classroom.

PROPOSED BUDGET

To turn our dreams into reality we are projecting the following costs:

Site Work (New Parking lots, EV charging stations, reconstructing main parking lot, expanded storm water detention, new screen refuse area, adjusting fire hydrants.)	\$ 2,500,000
Building Work (New library/media center, fourth preschool classroom, kitchenette, storage, new cooling systems, new south building entrance)	\$ 1,850,000
Furnishings (tables, chairs, desks, rolling book shelves, whiteboards, monitors, kitchenette items, etc)	\$ 500,000
Total	\$ 4,850,000
